

Fire Marshal Training

Duration:

Half day

Group Size:

Maximum of 8 delegates

Course Aims:

This training is designed to enable candidates to fully understand the duties of the modern fire marshal. The duty of care required to fulfill their role as the company's representatives with regard to fire safety and procedures.

- Training courses can be provided on your own premises or at our training venue in the centre of Birmingham.
- Practical "hands on" fire extinguisher usage on live fires, in a controlled training environment; using environmentally friendly training by fully trained operative(s).
- The course includes a record of attendance personal one (1) year attendance certificate.
- Objective and critique form completion on the day from each attendee. Designed for management to assess course inclusion.

Note: This is a highly intensive course, that may be physically demanding for some people: candidates nominated **MUST** be able and capable to pick up extinguishers.

Course outline:

- An understanding of the fire triangle and the common causes of fire.
- Sources of fuel and ignition.
- Roles of the modern fire marshal with regard to fire risk assessment and fire safety management, including checking procedures and hazard spotting.
- Action to be taken in the event of fire, to include raising the alarm, evacuation procedures, calling the fire and rescue service and dealing with special situations.
- To identify the different fire extinguishers and their methods of extinction with practical use on live controlled fires.
- Questions and Answers.

Terms and Conditions:

For courses held on your own premises a room of adequate size to hold 8 persons with the facility to erect a projector and screen is required. For the practical use of fire extinguishers on live fires a level hard standing area of 15 Square metres outside is also required, this must be clear of buildings, skips or any other combustible / flammable risks.
