

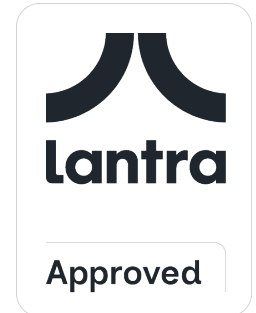

**Who should attend?**

Suitable for those intending to audit the standard of Temporary Traffic Management Operations and Installations against the applicable UK standards.

Course Aims:

The course aims to supplement learners with an insight into the applicable UK standards, documentation, and legislation for Temporary Traffic Management arrangements, to enhance their ability in identifying, recording and reporting conformances/non-conformances, by effectively referencing and relating their observations to the applicable UK standards.

Course Objectives:

- The Temporary Traffic Management Process
- An introduction to Key Reference Documents / Standards and how these apply
- Auditing different stages of the Temporary Traffic Management process
- Questions to raise during National Highways Sector Scheme 12 Audits
- Recording Audit Results
- The effective Reporting and Validation of Audit Observations
