Who Should Attend?

All persons who will be required by their employer to undertake the mobile lane closure technique as an advance warning vehicle driver on motorways and/or dual carriageways.

Course Aims:

To provide delegates with the necessary knowledge to assist them in becoming a competent member of an mobile lane closure team.

Course Objectives:

On completion of the session delegates will: -

- Understand the principles of Sector schemes, general health and safety at work, risk assessments and method statements associated with the mobile traffic management industry
- Reference documentation relevant to the mobile lane closure technique.
- Training and assessment requirements for mobile lane closure personnel.
- Vehicle and Equipment specification
- Communications roles and responsibilities
- Mobile lane closure principles and practical techniques
- The types of work that require full mobile lane closure techniques and the limitations
