Convoy Working

Duration:

Half a Day.

Group Size:

Maximum 12 delegates x 1 Instructor **or** Maximum 6 delegates x 1 Assessor.

Who Should Attend?

12D T4 is targeted at all persons needing to become a registered Traffic Management Convoy Working Operative as described in Sector Scheme document 12D.

Course Aims:

To provide delegates with the necessary underpinning technical knowledge and skill to convoy work on all 2 way roads and dual carriageway roads.

Course Objectives:

On completion of the session delegates will: -

- Be aware of sector schemes.
- Be aware of health & safety at work.
- Be aware of risk assessments & method statements.
- Be aware of relevant codes of practice and other associated documentation when involved in traffic management.
- Identify the equipment required in temporary traffic management.
- Understand the requirements for convoy working.
- Understand how convoy systems operate.

Certification:

On completion all delegates will be required to undertake a multiple choice examination which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards will issue a certificate to successful candidates. Candidates will be awarded 12D module T4 after successful completion of one site based assessment with a suitably qualified assessor in accordance with the awarding body's scheme rules. Refresher training is required every 5 years to keep your training updated and valid.

NB: Delegates must be qualified in 12D T1 & T2 prior to attending the 12D T4 course.
